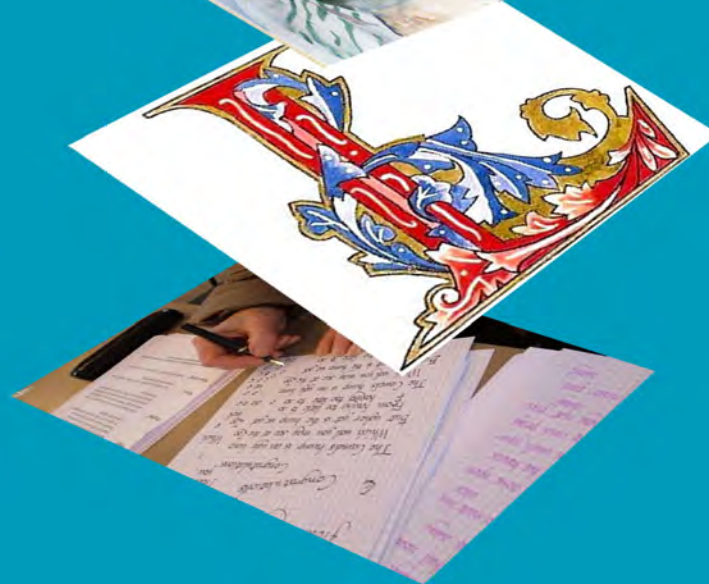

A list of flowers and materials required will be provided. Ideal for beginners and intermediate.



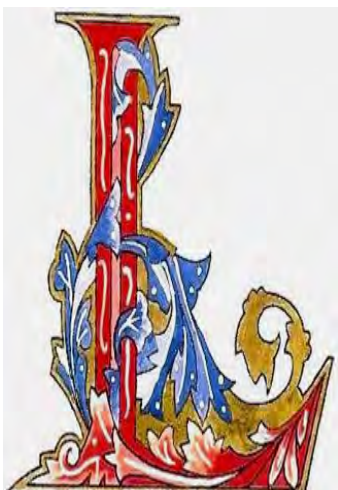
Paper Making with Plants
