AMNESTY INTERNATIONAL

Missing since December 2005, Iraq

Nathum Mohammad Isma'il al-'Ani was arrested by Iraqi security forces on 21 December 2005 along with his brother-in-law, Ahmed 'Abbas Khurshid al-Salihi. They were blindfolded, handcuffed and taken for interrogation with 16 other men, all apparently arrested on suspicion of involvement with armed opposition groups. Nathum al-'Ani, Ahmed al-Salihi and a third man were moved to what appeared to a private house, where they were held for 15 days and were reportedly denied toilet facilities and food, given little water, and were kicked, beaten with metal bars and partially suffocated with pillows to extract confessions. Ahmed al-Salihi was released on 4 January 2006, at the time he had a broken nose and shoulder. Later that month the body of one of the detainees, Firas Naji 'Abid Mikhlaf, was found in Baghdad. He had been strangled and had injuries consistent with torture. There has been no further news of Nathum al-'Ani or the 15 other men.

APPEAL – Please write asking for the whereabouts of Nathum Mohammad Isma'il al-'Ani and the other missing detainees to be made public. Call for an investigation and for those responsible to be brought to justice.
