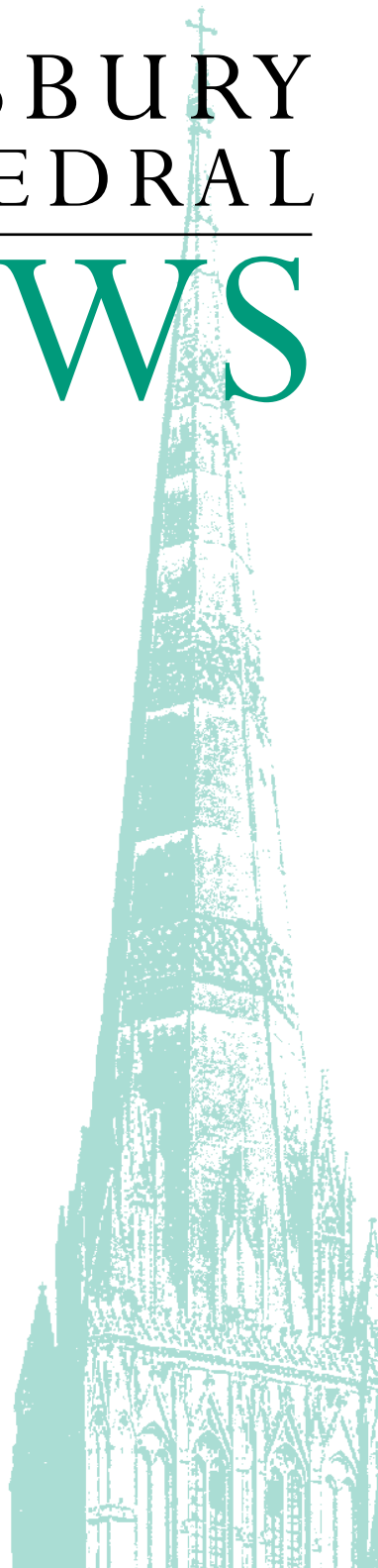

Tim Ravalde (19), the cathedral's current organ scholar, and organ scholar elect at St John's, Cambridge, gives the prestigious Clive Jenkinson Organ Recital on June 20 at 7.30pm.

"My recital is structured in two sections. The first is a group of shorter pieces including Mozart, Bach, Schübler, Whitlock and Croft. The second section of the recital will be a performance of Vieme's final and virtuosic *Symphonie VI opus 59*. This was his last major composition and displays his great skills. A magnificent piece, it has a wonderfully relaxed and bright atmosphere."

Daniel Cook, Assistant Director of Music and responsible for the Organ Recital Series, added, "This recital promises to be one of the highlights of this year's series and will be a fitting finale to Tim's time here as organ scholar."
